As I already mentioned in my article, using the dollar sign “\$”, quotation marks, and exclamation points in subject lines can trigger Spam filters, as well as using all capital letters. I would also strongly recommend that you never include a toll-free number in the subject line—yep, that will trigger Spam filters too.

Please note that the above lists aren't meant to be comprehensive and only identify some of the more common words and phrases that trigger Spam filters.
